Website	A set of related web pages located under a single domain name. (URL- www.....com.uk/org)
Reliable	A reliable source of information can be trusted and backed up as true/credible

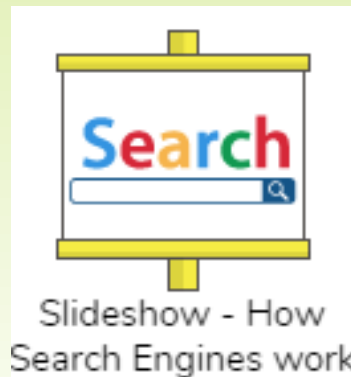
Sticky Knowledge
