### VOCABULARY

**Society:** a group of people living together in an ordered community.

**Contribute:** to give money or other resources to a charity.

**Charity:** a group that gives time, money or actions to help others who need it.

**Aid:** to give support or help to those who need it.

**International:** when something is international, it takes place in several countries.

**Responsibility:** a responsibility is something you have to do or look after.

**Saving:** this is what you do in order to be able to afford to buy something—you keep some of your money every week/month to one side until you have enough saved.

**Voluntary:** something that is done through choice with no money paid for doing it.
