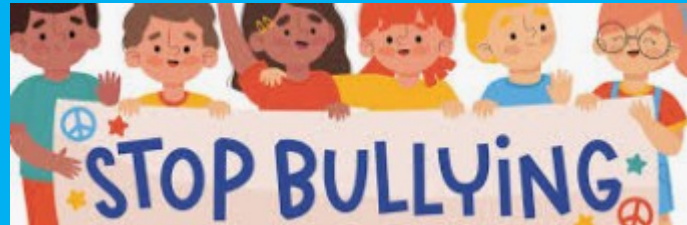




## BULLYING – YEAR 5



Developing good relationships and respecting differences between people

### VOCABULARY

**Commitment:** a pledge or a promise

**Violence:** intense physical action and aggression

**Victim:** the person being bullied

**Bystander:** someone who is present but not involved

**Upstander:** someone who is present and works to stop/report the bullying

**Perpetrator:** the bully

### STICKY KNOWLEDGE

Bystanders have responsibilities during bullying situations. They need to become upstanders:

- Do not join us
- Protect the victim if possible
- Do not gossip about incidents
- Inform someone
- Check on the welfare of the victim

Bystanders can be seen as guilty alongside the offender if they do not act to protect where possible.

Tell someone if you are or someone else is being bullied – your teacher, parents, friends, the Anti-bullying co-ordinator, for online bullying tell CEOP.
