KEY VOCABULARY

Colour: we describe how an object looks based on the way it reflects or absorbs light

Shade: adding black to a colour to darken it

Blend: two colours are slightly mixed together to give a smooth transition from one to the other

Mix: combine two or more colours

Primary: colours that can't be created by mixing other colours

Secondary: colours made from mixing two primary colours

Tertiary: made by combining equal parts of primary and secondary colours

'MONA LISA' 1903



STICKY KNOWLEDGE

Tertiary colours are made by mixing equal amounts of two **primary** or **secondary** colours.

Primary colours are: **yellow**, **red** and **blue**.

Secondary colours are: **orange**, **purple** and **green**.

Tertiary colours are: **amber**, **vermillion**, **magenta**, **violet**, **teal**, **chartreus**.
