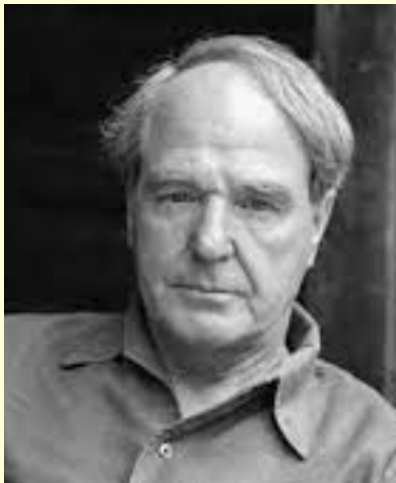
Form is a 3D object with volume and thickness.

FAMOUS PEOPLE



Henry Moore 1898-1986

Henry Moore is famous for his sculptures of people with bumpy forms and hollow spaces in their bodies. His sculptures sometimes had holes right through them! He also used flowing, abstract shapes in his sculptures.

Barbara Hepworth 1903-1975

Instead of making art that looked like people or things, Hepworth began to make sculptures and drawings using abstract shapes. She was inspired by nature and the world around her.



Vocabulary

Sculpture- an artistic form in which hard or plastic materials are worked into three-dimensional art objects.

Form- form refers to objects that are 3-Dimensional, or have length, width, and height.

Shape- a flat area surrounded by edges or an outline.

Volume- a three-dimensional unit of space made up of height, width, and length.

Thickness- the depth/ weight of a line.

Texture- the feel of the surface (e.g rough, smooth).

Soak- to immerse in a liquid.

Squeeze- to firmly press.

Wrap- to cover or enclose something.

Layer- to place one sheet of material on top of another.

Set- to let a material harden into a particular shape.
