STEPHEN WILTSHIRE (B. 1974)

Stephen is famous for drawing detailed **cityscapes** from memory. As a child, Stephen was diagnosed with autism. At age 5, teachers noticed that he loved to draw, and he would communicate with the world through drawings.

In 2001, he appeared in a BBC documentary, **Fragments of Genius**, in which he was filmed flying over London aboard a helicopter and then completing a detailed illustration which included 12 historic landmarks and 200 other structures.

STICKY KNOWLEDGE

The parts of the object on which the light is strongest are called **highlights** and the darker areas are called **shadows**.

KEY VOCABULARY

Light: a source of illumination.

Highlight: draw special attention to something by making it stand out.

Dark: with little or no light.

Shadow: the dark side on an object not facing the light.

Reflection: the mirror-image of something.
