KEY VOCABULARY

Tint: adding white to a colour to lighten it

Shade: adding black to a colour to darken it.

Hue: any name we give a colour or combination of pigments

Mood: the atmosphere or feeling in a painting

Emotion: the way feelings are expressed in a piece of artwork

Expressionism: art that conveys emotion and meaning rather than reality
