KEY VOCABULARY

Feeling: the emotions that a photograph provokes

Perspective: the way 3D objects are represented in 2D artwork

Close up: focusing on close up details
Zoom: to change from a long shot to a close
up and vice versa

Pan: the horizontal movement of the camera

Tilt: the vertical movement of the camera

Point of view (POV): looking through the camera from a character's perspective (through their eyes)

Soft focus, sharpen, blur, contrast, brightness, vibrance, saturation, warmth, vignette are all editing tools

Photographs can be taken using different camera angles and perspectives. (front/ side).

Photographs can portray different feelings and emotions.

Different editing tools can change and enhance an original image in lots of different ways.
