## STICKY KNOWLEDGE

**Bullying impacts on the victim:** 

- Loneliness
- → Fear
- Low mood
- Acting out
- Not wanting to come to school

Bullying can impact on the bully too:

- Low self-esteem
- Initially feel powerful
- Potentially end up lonely
- Having a bad reputation
- → Bullies are feared
- Bullies have no real friends
