VOCABULARY

Manners: being respectful and saying 'Please' and 'Thank-you'

Courtesy: using your manners and always being polite

STICKY KNOWLEDGE

The conventions of courtesy and manners are:

- Saying please, thank you and excuse me
- Holding doors open
- Paying attention (no technology)
- Giving eye contact
