VOCABULARY

Commitment: a pledge or a promise

Violence: intense physical action and

aggression

Victim: the person being bullied

Bystander: someone who is present but

not involved

Perpetrator: the bully

STICKY KNOWLEDGE

Bystanders have responsibilities during bullying situations:

- Do not join us
- Protect the victim if possible
- Do not gossip about incidents
- Inform someone
- Check on the welfare of the victim

Bystanders can be seen as guilty alongside the offender if they do not acts to protect where possible.
