**The Parliament of the United Kingdom is
split into three separate parts:**
The House of Commons (the lower house)
The Lords (the upper house)
The Monarch

**Most legislative power is in the House of
Commons. It is made up of 650 Members of
Parliament (MPs). These people are elected
by the people of the United Kingdom.**

**The House of Lords has the power to reject
Bills, except tax bills, and make the House of
Commons reconsider them.**

**The monarch is the fount of all power in the
UK**
