The United Nations (UN) is an organization between countries established in 1945 to promote international cooperation. It was set up following World War II to prevent another conflict. When it was founded, the UN had 51 member states; there are now 193.

The aims are:

To keep peace throughout the world
To develop friendly relations among nations
To help nations work together to improve the lives of poor people, to conquer hunger, disease and illiteracy, and to encourage respect for each other's rights and freedoms
To be a centre for harmonizing the actions of nations to achieve these goals
