Key Knowledge and Understanding

The 5 lines on which musical notation is written on is called the stave

Musical notation written down on a stave tells us what notes the composer of the music wants us to play and when


Notes have different pitches, for example you can have a high pitched F or a low pitched F. The position of the note on the stave tells us which one to play.

Key Vocabulary	Definition
Pitch	How low or high the note made sounds
Rhythm	The length each note is played or sung for
Duration	The length each note is played or sung for
Dynamics	The volume of the sound being produced
