Key Knowledge and Understanding

A symphonic poem is a piece of orchestral music, usually in a single continuous movement, which illustrates or evokes the content of a poem, short story, novel, painting, landscape, or other (non-musical) source.

Body percussion is the use of different parts of the body to create music. As it seems logical that early man was probably accompanying the creation of his own music with the clapping of his palms and the beating of his feet, it is likely to have a history going back to prehistoric times.

Notation is just writing music down so players can easily read the pitch and duration of the notes they are supposed to play. You can use music notes drawn on a stave.




