

Key Vocabulary	Definition
Canon	a piece of voices (or instrumental parts) that sing or play the same music starting at different times.
Motif	short musical idea that is repeated in different ways through a piece of music
Orchestrate	arrange or score (music) for orchestral performance.
Loop	repeating section of sound material. Short sections of material can be repeated to create ostinato patterns.

Music is increasingly becoming more difficult to define in genres . As we move towards streaming services, is it frequently sorted by vibe which also seems considerably more in tune with how and why people listen to music these days.

Traditionally the four main body percussion sounds (in order from lowest pitch to highest in pitch) are: stomp (stamping), patsch (patting the thighs with hands), clapping, clicking. Other possibilities are: hitting the chest, whistling, slapping or flicking the cheeks with an open mouth, clicking with the tongue against the roof of the mouth, changing the playing technique changes the sound created. For example, clapping the hands in various positions will affect factors such as pitch and resonance.

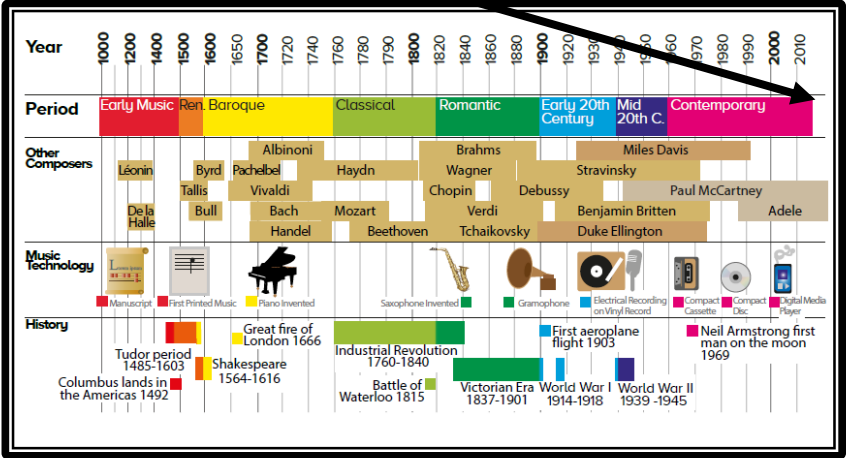
