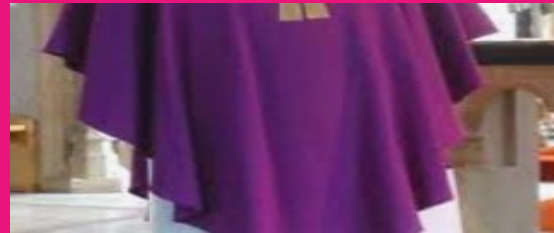
STICKY KNOWLEDGE – ADVENT

Advent is a time of preparation for Christians. One candle is lit for each Sunday in Advent, leading to the fifth central candle lit on Christmas morning representing Jesus.

The four candles represent hope, peace, joy (pink), love. The wreath is circular and evergreen for everlasting love.

A fifth candle is lit on Christmas morning to show the light of Jesus.

The colour associated with advent is purple which relates to royalty.
