THE BIG QUESTION

Why didn't Jesus leave if he knew he was going to die?

KEY VOCABULARY

Palm leaf	A leaf, especially of a palmetto, that is used in making hats, fans, and the like.
Jealous	Feeling envy of what another person has or can do.
Christian	One who believes in the divine nature of Jesus Christ and follows his words and teachings.
Supper	An evening meal.
Slavery	The owning of people by other people.

STICKY KNOWLEDGE

Palm Sunday - Jesus rode on a donkey into Jerusalem and put palm branches on the floor. They treated him as a King which made leaders jealous.

Maundy Thursday - Christians remember when Jesus ate the bread and wine at the last supper. Maundy means command - given by Jesus that we should love one another.

Last Supper - the meal eaten by Christ with his disciples before he was crucified.

Christians receive bread and wine at church on Sundays to remember the body and blood of Jesus. This is called Holy Communion or Mass.

Jews celebrate Passover at a similar time to Easter. It remembers the Israelites freedom from slavery. Jews have a Seder meal with Matzot bread and wine to celebrate.

Music is a form of worship for Christians and is a form of spiritual expression.
