STICKY KNOWLEDGE

The Ten Commandments are the rules God wanted Christians to live by.

The 10 Commandments are found in the Old Testament. The Ten Commandments were written by God upon two tablets of stone and then given to Moses on Mount Sinai.

The Commandments are: have no other gods; do not make an idol or any likeness; do not take the name of the Lord God in vain; remember the Sabbath; honour your father and mother; you shall not murder; you shall not commit adultery; you shall not steal; you shall not bear false witness; you shall not covet anything that belongs to your neighbour.

The 5 pillars of Islam are: declaration of faith (Shahadah), daily prayer (Salat), charity (Zakat), fasting (Sawm); pilgrimage to Mecca (Hajj).

An Islamic bible is a Qur'an.
