Death



KEY VOCABULARY

Funeral	A ceremony for a dead person.
Cremation	When a person has died and their body is burnt rather than buried leaving behind ashes.
Burial	The act of putting a dead body underground or in the sea.
Urn	A large vase with a base which holds a persons ashes after cremation.
Scattered	The act of separating ashes in all directions.
Afterlife	Life after death.

STICKY KNOWLEDGE – DEATH

When a person dies a funeral is held for family and friends to remember them, to celebrate their life and to say goodbye.

A Christian funeral will start with a church service led by a vicar/priest. There will be bible readings, hymns and tributes are given by family members/friends.

After the service there is a burial or cremation. Ashes are kept in an urn and scattered in a special place.

Christians believe in the afterlife where people are welcomed into God's kingdom in heaven.

Muslim's worship in a mosque and the religious leader is an Imam.
