KEY VOCABULARY

Gospel	Any of the four accounts of Jesus Christ's life, death, and teachings in the New Testament books of Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John.
Messiah	According to the New Testament, Jesus Christ, regarded as the fulfilment of this prophecy; Christ.
Register	To sign up for something by having one's name put on an official list.
Tax	A sum of money paid to a government, which the government uses to pay for its services to the people and to maintain itself.
Shepherds	A person who herds and watches over sheep.

There are 4 Gospels in the bible (Matthew, Mark, Luke, John).

The special title given to the baby Jesus was Messiah, Emmanuel or King of the Jews – the chosen one. Jesus was born in Bethlehem. The baby was born there because this was the home town where they were required to register.
