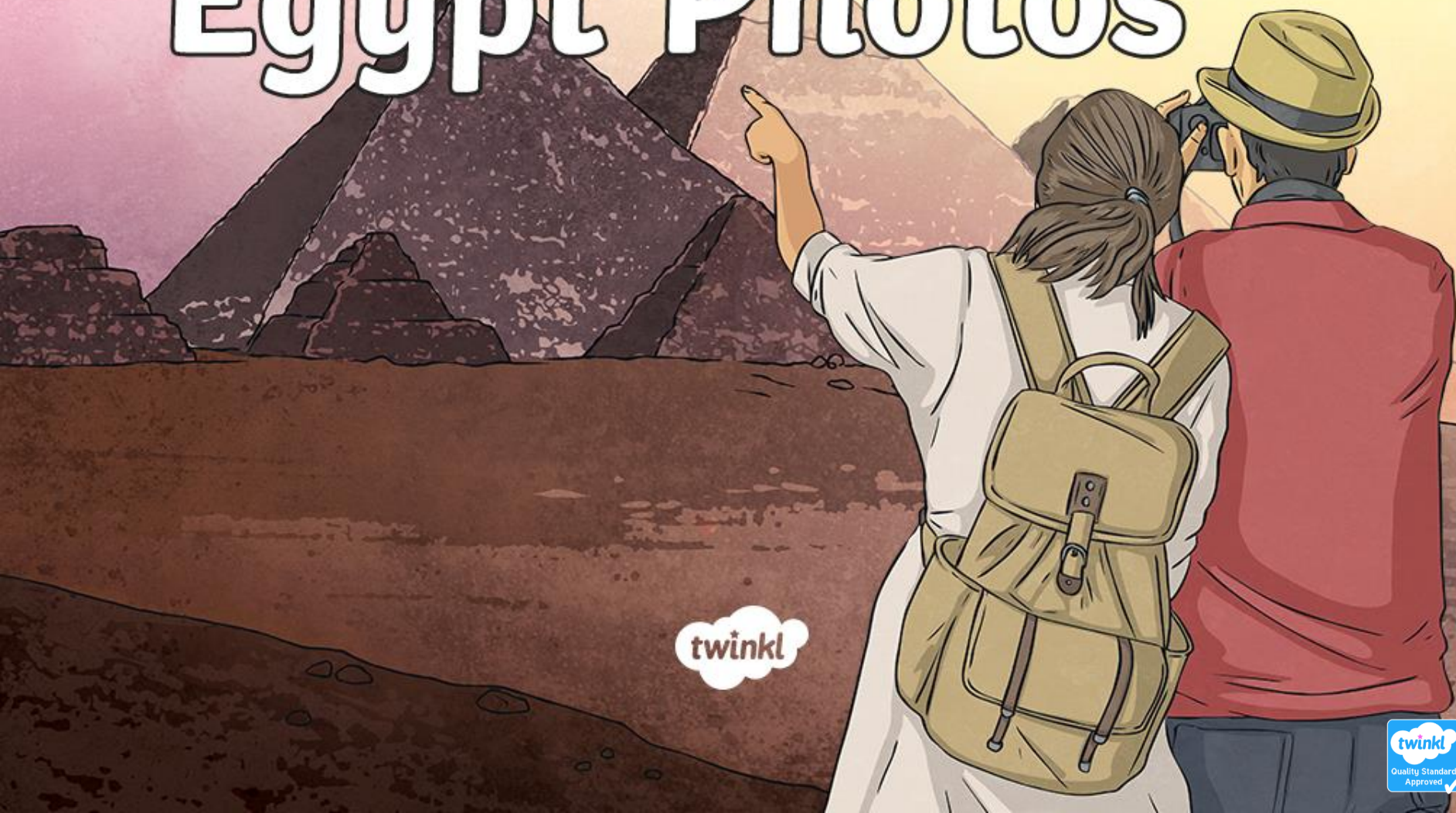














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 **Cartonnage** Mummy Case, about 550–450 BC
Cartonnage: plaster and gold, with glass eyes.
Late Period: Chertise to early Roman Empire.
The mummy case is made of cartonnage, a material made of plaster and straw, and is decorated with colorful hieroglyphs and figures. The head is covered in a gold mask with a blue and white patterned band. The coffin is shown in a glass display case, with other artifacts visible in the background.



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
