

enough. We also need you to bring you diary into school every day.



Just like you will be used to at John T Rice, we have maths and English lessons every day. As part of our English lesson we will learn the new grammar rules for year 3 and practise the

grammar rules from year 2. We will develop our writing skills with lots of imaginative and exciting writing as well. It's really important we learn our times tables as well so we practise in school every day.





Welcome to year 3

Every week we give out homework to be completed at home. There will usually be a piece of maths homework and a piece of English homework., as well a weekly spellings to practise. Occasionally we will also set a topic based activity which will be more research based



Each term our learning will be based around a different topic. In the autumn term we learn about Early Man, in the spring term we discover the Ancient Egyptians and in the summer well be studying out local mining area.



Each week we have two weekly PE lessons so we need PE kits to always be in school. There is no reason to take PE kits home as they will be sent home every holiday. In year 3
