Thank you for your support at our sports day event. It is always lovely to see our school community together.

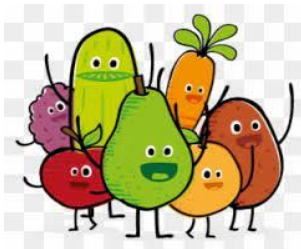
A huge well done to all the pupils taking part and to our winning RED team.
